The Research and Development Cell of the department takes every effort to inculcate a passion for research among the UG and PG students as well.

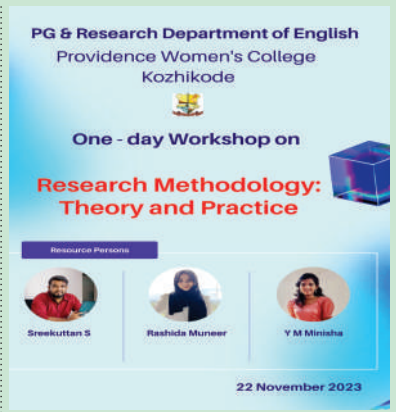

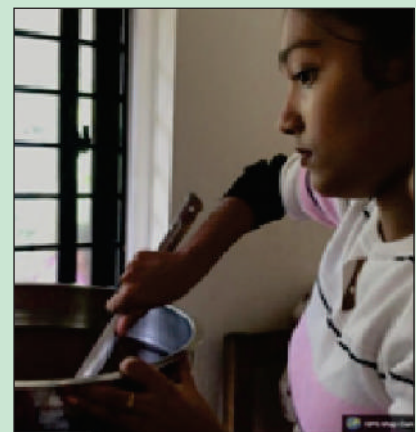
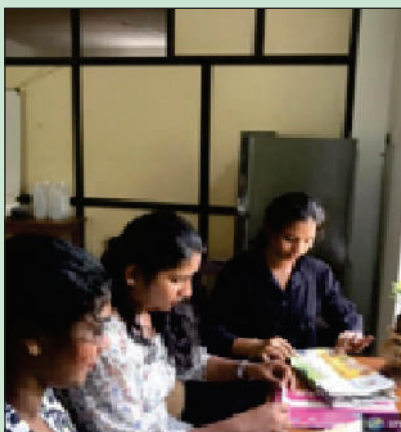
CLOTH DONATION DRIVE

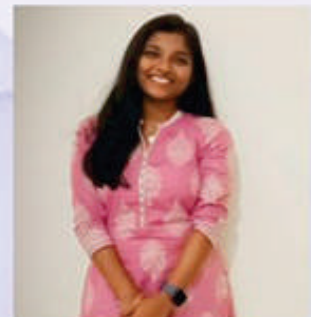
