HIGHLIGHTS

EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING AND EXPOSURE

During the academic year 2024–25, the Department organized four field trips, institutional visits, and a study tour to Agra and Jaipur to enhance experiential learning and provide academic exposure. The activities included:

- Tea Factory Visit – Chelottu Estate, Vythiri Panchayath, Wayanad (29/09/2024): Students learned about indigenous tea production techniques, contributing to quality education.
- Sargalaya Visit – (29/10/2024): A field study to understand the challenges faced by artisans and the handicraft sector.
- Handloom Industry Visit – Koothampally, Ottappalam, Palakkad (28/02/2025): Students explored traditional hand weaving and handloom production.
- Leather and Footwear Industry Visit – Agra (06/02/2025): Part of the Agra study tour, focusing on the leather industry and shoe manufacturing.
- Institutional Visit to KILA (Kerala Institute of Local Administration) – (28/02/2025): Students attended a session on the "Disability Bill for Self-Governance Institutions."



CAMPUS PLACEMENT AND KPSC REGISTRATION CAMP

An exclusive campus placement drive was organized for the students of VI Semester B.A. Economics, in collaboration with Muthoot Securities Limited. The drive included personal interviews for 40 students, followed by an online written exam to be completed by the last week of April. Selected students will undergo training at Rajagiri College of Management, starting in the first week of May.

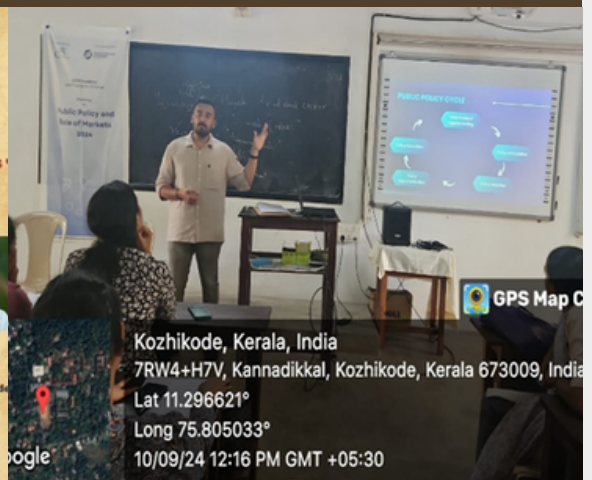
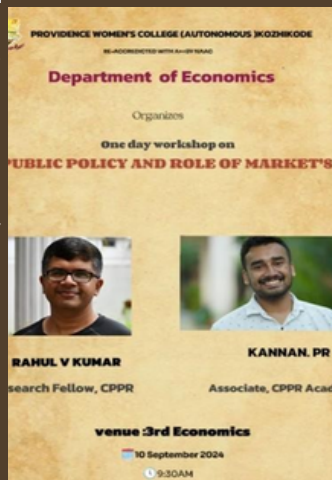

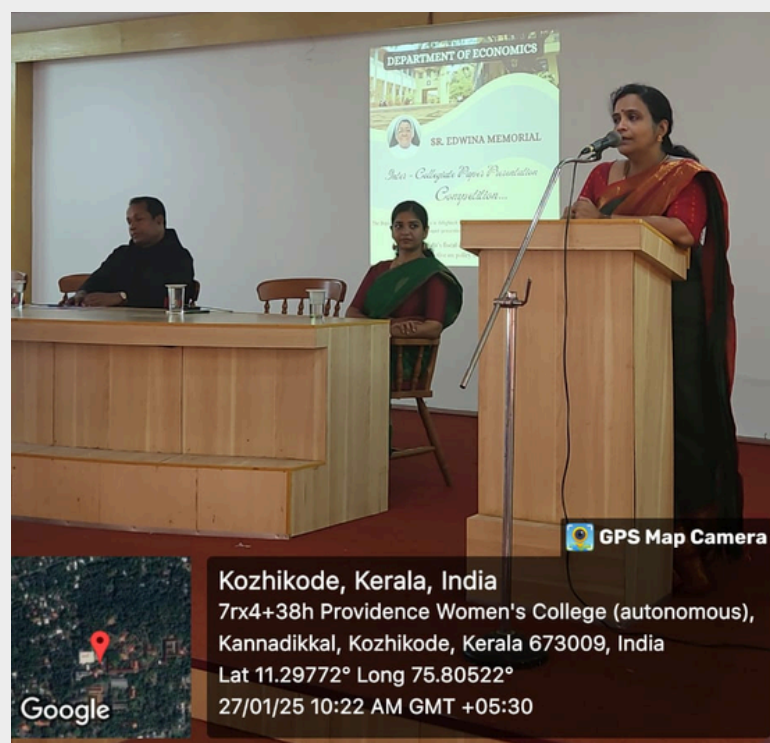
ACADEMIC SESSIONS

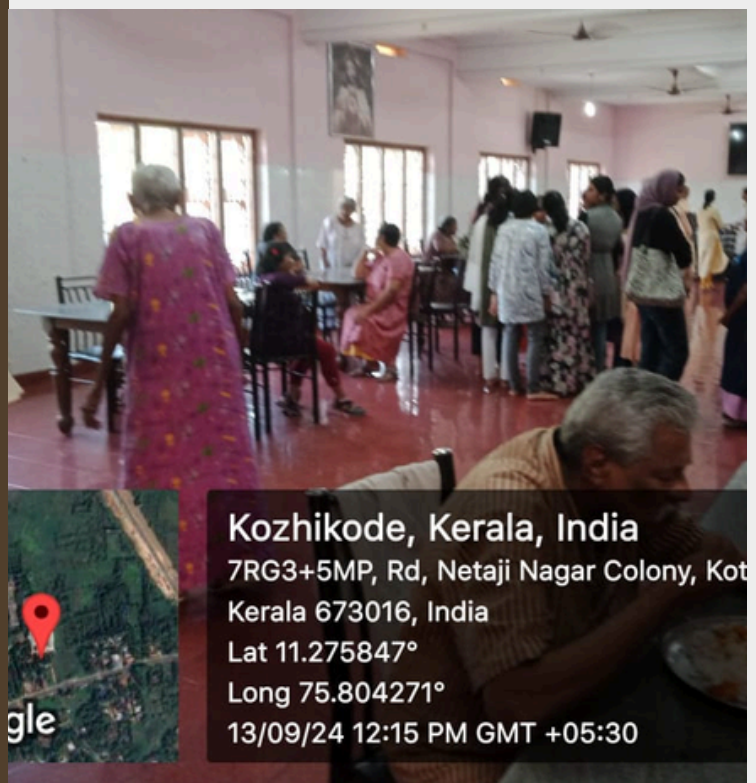


EXTENSION PROGRAMMES
