Ayisha Rifna of 2nd year has won 3rd prize for oppana and 1st prize for mobile photography as a part of student's day conducted by college union.



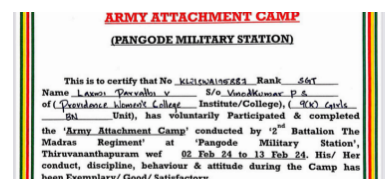

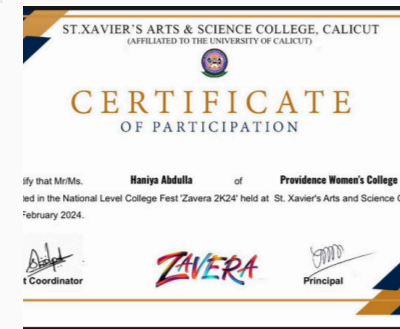
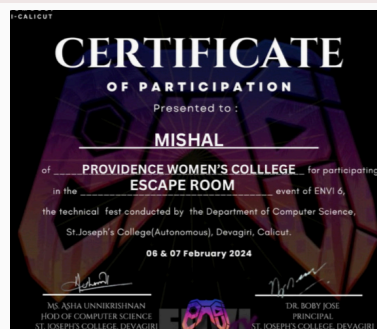
STUDENTS' PARTICIPATION IN EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

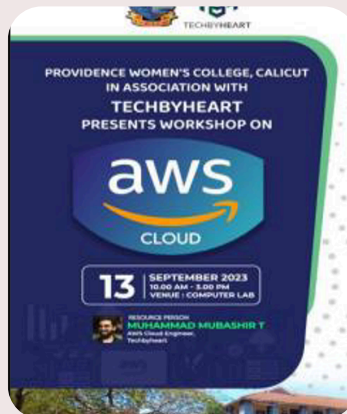

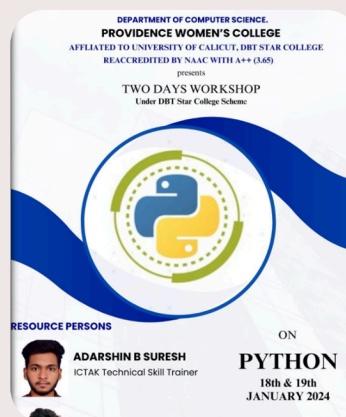
ONE-DAY WORKSHOP ON MOBILE APP DEVELOPMENT USING KOTLIN

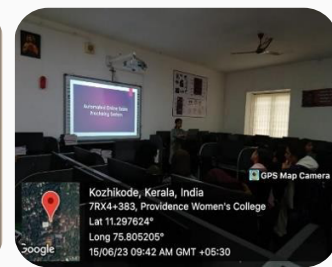
ONE DAY WORKSHOP ON UI/UX

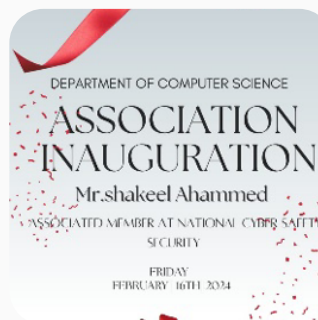

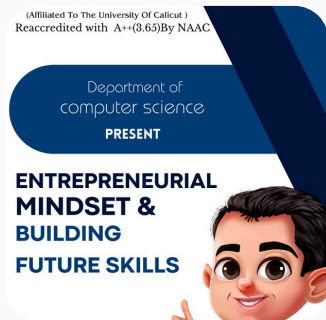
ENVIRONMENT CLUB(EARTHLINKS)

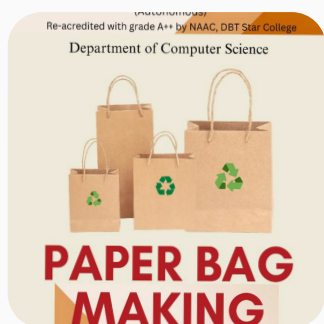
On 14th July 2023, the Environmental Club of the Department of Computer Science set up an indoor garden (GreenCo) in front of the department.

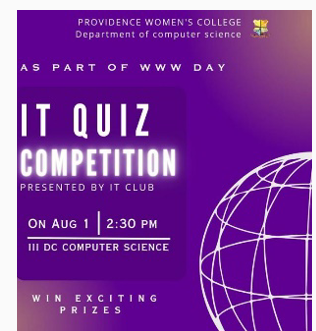
National Reading Day

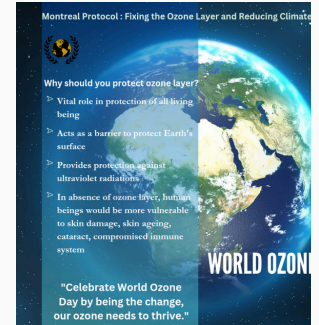
As part of India celebrating its 77th Independence Day, the Computer Science Department conducted a poster-making competition on August 18, 2023. Students from our department actively participated in the program.

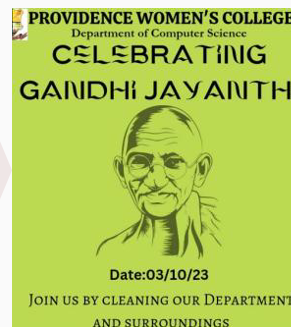

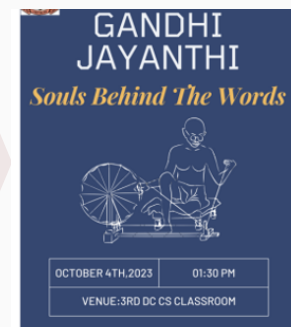


Gandhi Jayanthi

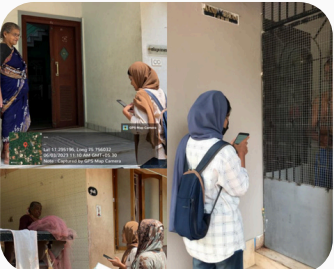
EXTENSION ACTIVITIES

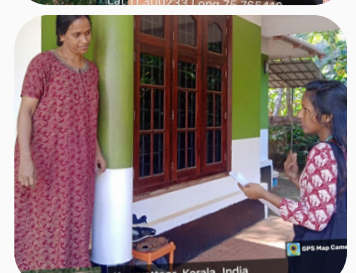

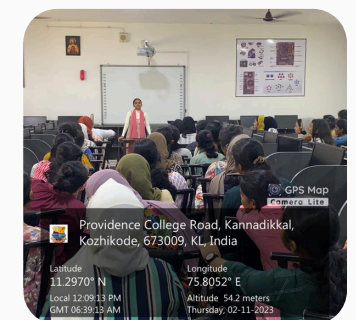

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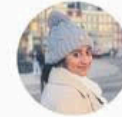
