Objectives of the project are use of animal manure as pond biofertilizer, use of crops by-products as supplementary feed for fish, use of pond sediments as terrestrial crop bio

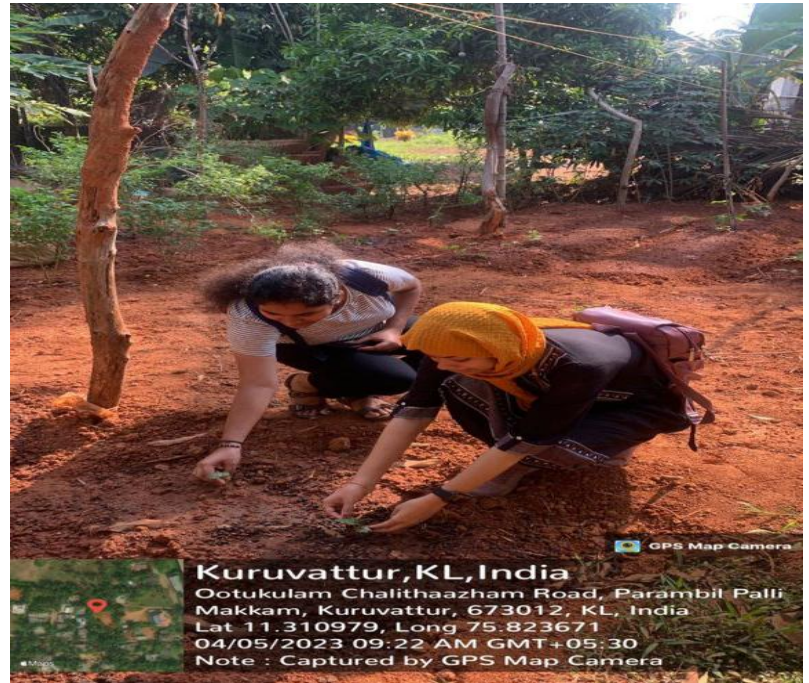
manure and use of aquaculture wastewater for crop irrigation

and submitted to the Honorable State Tourism Minister Mr. Muhammad Riyas.





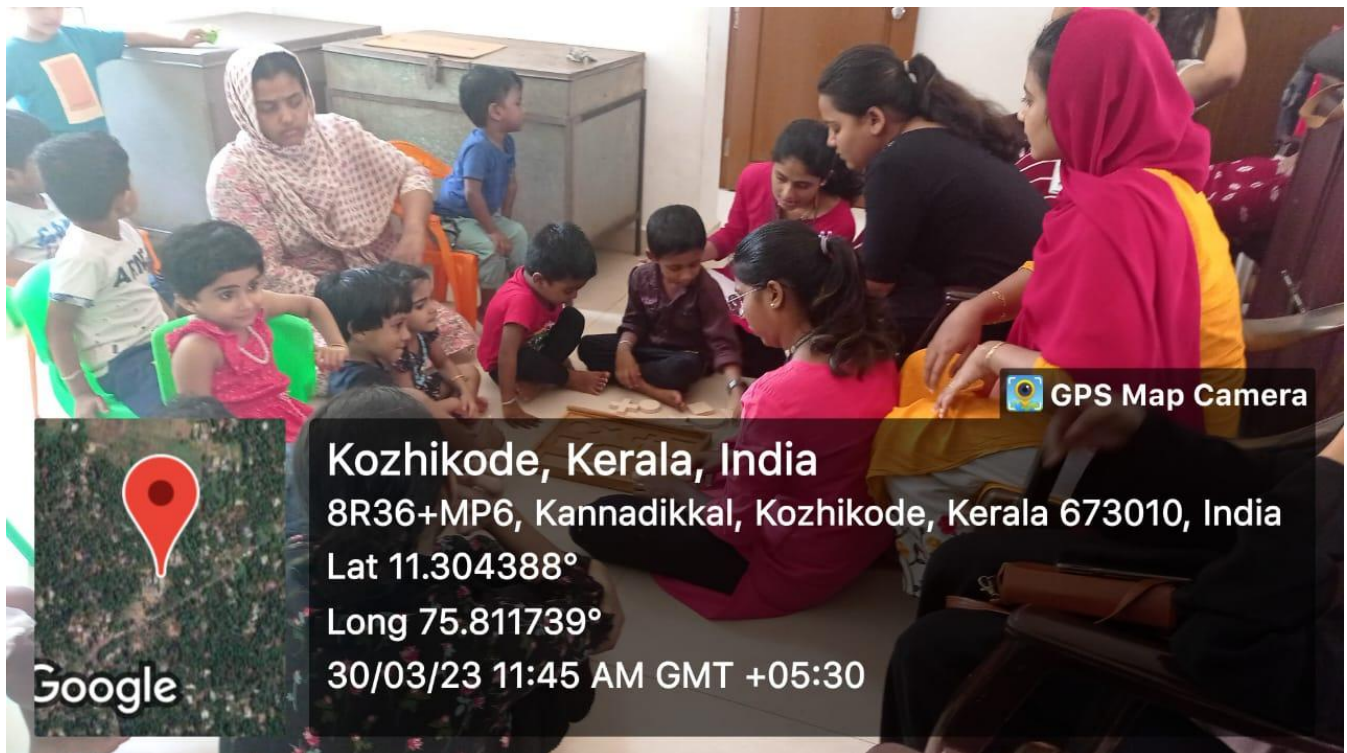
## Intelligent assessment of preschoolers

this project to other adopted villages of UBA





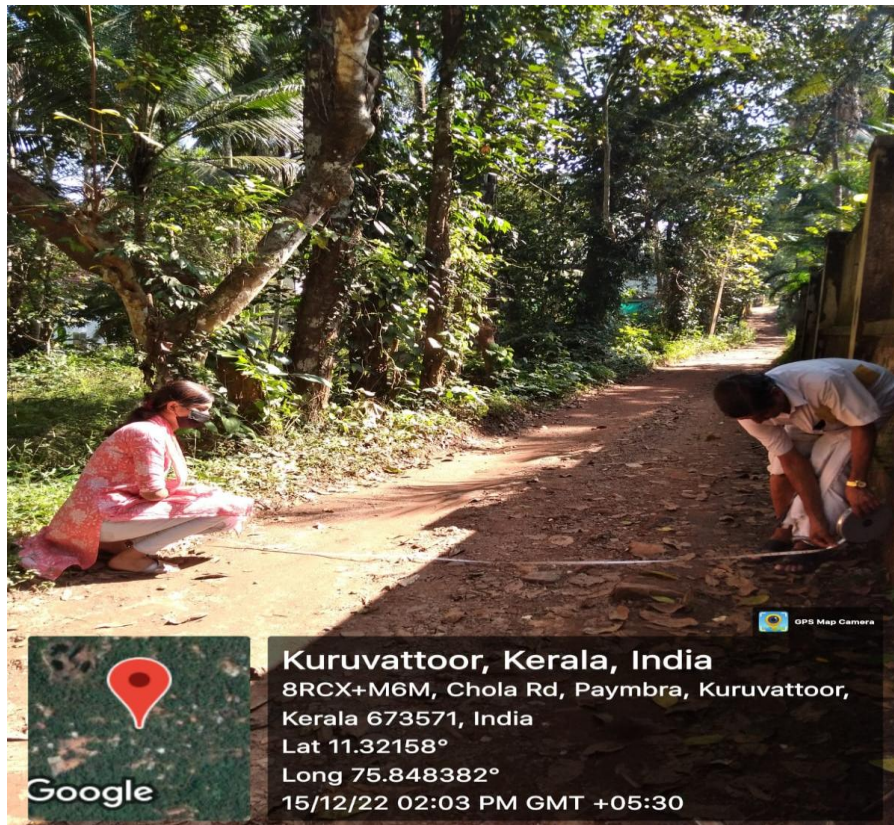
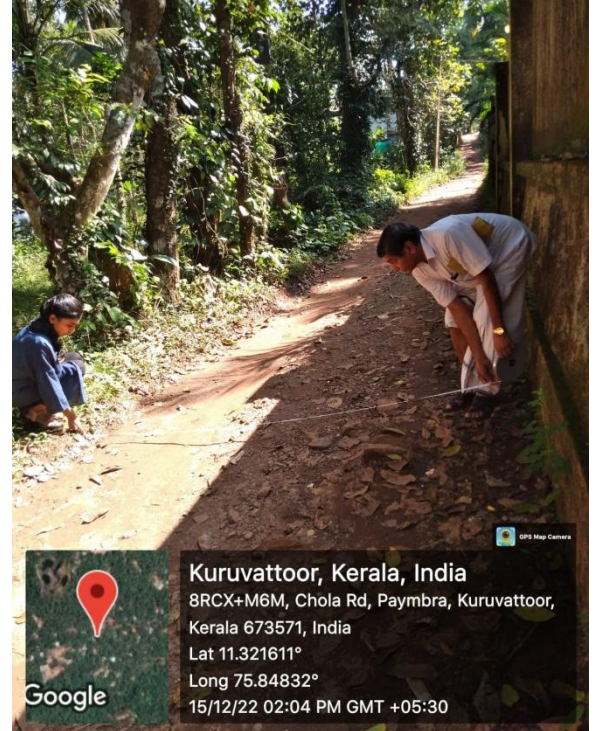
## Road mapping

road which is not included in the asset of the Panchayath. This was done as a voluntary work as per the request from the officials.

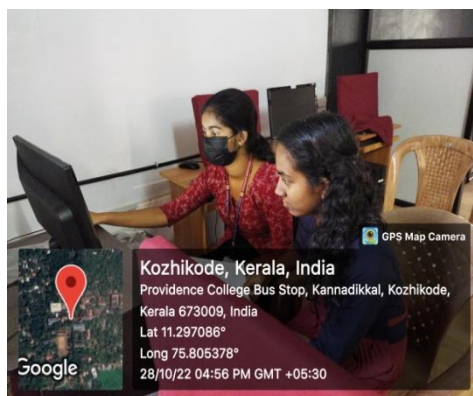




## Keep the old documents in a new form

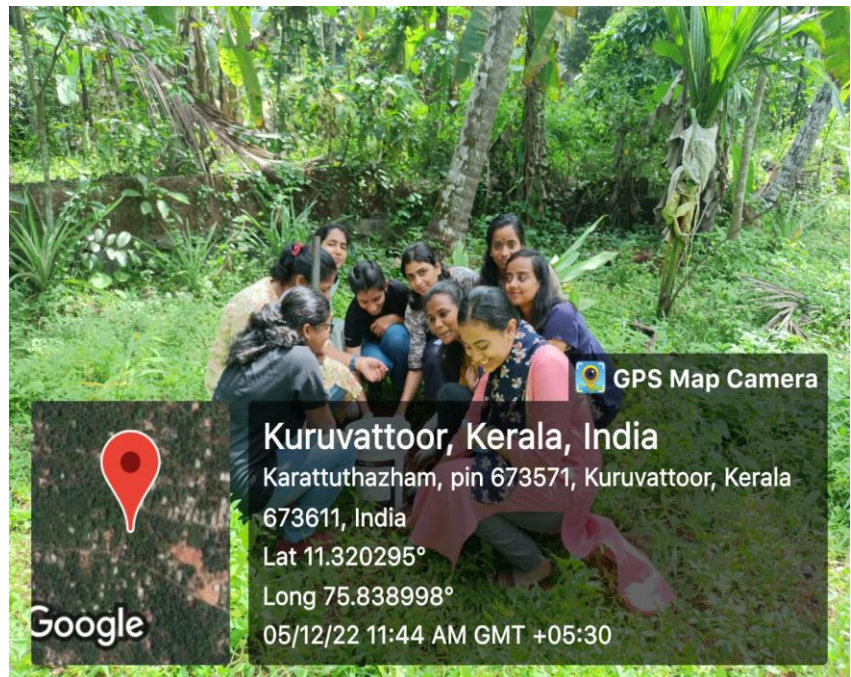




## Soil collection for analysis

UBA volunteers collected soil samples from the farmers and send to soil analysis laboratory at Thikodi.

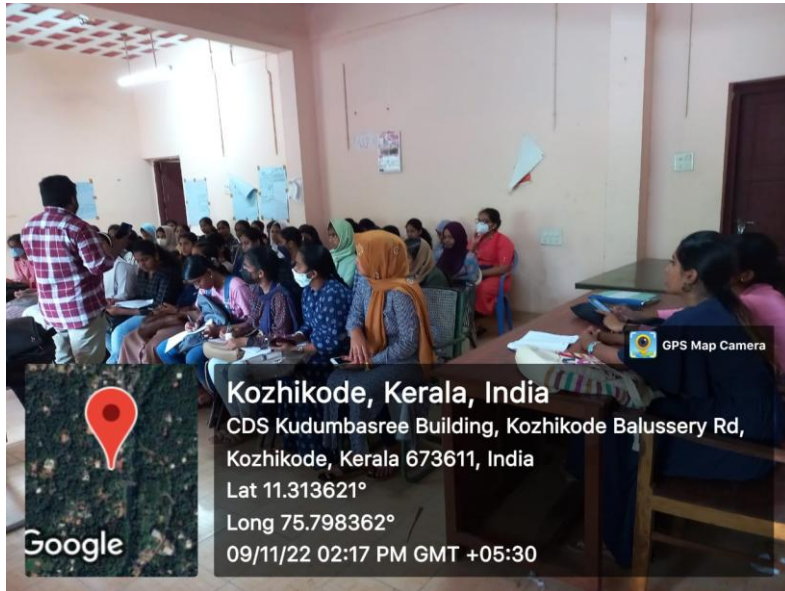




## Haritha Mitram Project @ Kakkodi

## EMPLOYMENT SURVEY

Selected villages: **Vengeri village of Kozhikode corporation & Kakkodi village**

One of the common problems faced by the households of the adopted villages, is the absence of a steady work and source of income. The UBA volunteers of Department of Economics with an aim to understand the unemployment situation and the skill sets of the people, conducted a survey in Vengeri and Kakkodi. 152 households were covered in the survey among which 80 households belong to Vengeri village and 72 households belong to Kakkodi panchayath. Many respondents have expressed their willingness to attend skill oriented programmes if arranged. 50 respondents who are skilled are seeking employment opportunities. The employment survey was conducted during the months of March and April .
